

Ohio Fraternal Alliance College Scholarship

The Ohio Fraternal Alliance annually awards a college scholarship to a graduating high school senior.

The eligibility requirements are as follows:

- Applicant must be an Ohio resident. Applicant must be a member of LPSCU. Applicant must be a current youth policy member of a fraternal society, and be in good standing.
- Applicant must be a graduating high school senior attending an accredited college, university, trade or technical school, or school of nursing as a full-time student in the fall following high school graduation.
- Applicant must submit a minimum 150-word essay on the assigned topic for the year (which can be obtained by contacting the individual listed at the bottom).
- Applicant must submit a separate list for each of the following categories:
 - Church related activities
 - Local community and volunteer activities
 - School activities/clubs
- Applicant must submit a letter of recommendation from your local Fraternal Society officer explaining your involvement in your Fraternal Society.
